The Sculpture Trail is a 2km farm and forest walk around Five Bob Farm (home of Diemen Pepper). The annual Sculpture Prize Exhibition along, with our permanent acquisitions, are a celebration for the senses and mind: stimulating, subversive, current, reflective and sometimes simply fun.

The Sculpture Trail is 2km long & suitable for most ages and abilities.

The trail is undulating, moderately steep for the first half of the trail. We've provided artistic benches along the walk for visitors to take a rest & enjoy the view. We ask for your co-operation in protecting art works & supervising children around the sculptures.

Dogs on leads are welcome, there are no bins provided so please take all waste including dog bags with you.

The trail is open 7 days a week, year round

Entry Fee - \$5 pp / \$10 per family

Farm Walks: A visit to Five Bob Farm (home of Diemen Pepper), includes farm & forest walks which will take you through the kitchen garden, pear orchard, flower & pepperberry crops.
